- Fees:**
- Fees include materials.
 - A **separate** check payable to the instructor indicated on the description is required for each class.

- Registration:**
- **Registration forms are processed in the order in which they arrive at the After School Programs Office.**
 - Registration forms must be filled out completely and signed in order to be processed.
 - All fees must accompany application in order to be processed.
 - Registration deadline is January 31, 2012. Registrations received after January 31st are subject to a \$10.00 late fee paid directly to DMUSD.
 - Class confirmations will be emailed to you.
 - **In the event the class will not be held your check will be shredded.**
 - **Classes are held on your child's school campus unless otherwise noted. Room locations will be posted on the district website (www.dmusd.org) prior to the start of the session.**

**Provisions and
Conditions
of Enrollment:**

- **For the safety of the children...** If a child is unfamiliar with the campus, parents must accompany their child or make arrangements to have someone direct their child to the proper location for the first meeting of a class. Escorts are not available to walk children to their class. The Del Mar Union School District is not responsible for your student's attendance in his/her enrichment class. Mark your calendar to be sure your student attends. The administration of this program is separate from the school. Please **do not** phone the school office to remind your child to attend.
- It is imperative that students are picked up immediately after a class. Parents should meet their students at the class location. Any parent who is more than 10 minutes late in picking up their child will be charged at the rate of \$2.00 per minute, payable to the instructor at the time of pick-up. The student will not be permitted to return to the program until the late fee is paid.
- Classes are designed for students who are interested in attending and in conducting themselves in an appropriate manner. Inappropriate behavior will be discussed with the parent and may result in dismissal from class without a refund. The instructor's decision to dismiss a child shall be final.
- Once classes are established, **no refunds** will be made.
- There will be only one make-up day held in the event that class is cancelled due to rain.
