



Education Protection Account (EPA) Funding

The Education Protection Account (EPA) was created in November 2012 by Proposition 30, *The Schools and Local Public Safety Protection Act of 2012*. The EPA is governed by Section 36 of Article XIII of the California Constitution, which was amended by Proposition 55 in November 2016.

Each community college district, county office of education, school district, and charter school shall annually publish on its Internet website an accounting of how much money was received from the Education Protection Account and how that money was spent.
