Teacher Input Regarding Kindergarten Schedule

Board Report February 15, 2023

Timeline

- Per Board member request, a Special Board Meeting was held on August 4, 2022 for the purpose of discussing full day kindergarten, every day, beginning on the first day of school for the 2022-2023 school year.
- Board gave direction to engage with parents and teachers to get input during the 2022-2023 school year.

Current Kindergarten Schedule

 Kindergarten students attend school on a minimum day schedule for the first six weeks of school and a full day schedule beginning the seventh week of school for the remainder of the school year.

Process for Input

- Get input from parents October Survey
 - 978 respondents (kindergarten sixth grade)
 - 57% indicated interest in full day kindergarten beginning on the first day of school
 - 43% indicated interest in keeping the current schedule
- Get input from teachers November to January
 - 100% of district kindergarten teams provided input via in-person meetings
 - 100% of individual kindergarten teachers strongly recommended maintaining the six-week minimum day schedule
- Report new information to the Board February

Teacher Feedback Results

- Each team expressed appreciation for the six-week assessment period.
- All teams unanimously expressed a strong desire to continue the current six-week minimum day schedule.

Key Benefits

- The six week period allows teachers to
 - Assess the academic needs of students
 - Engage with students on an individual level allowing teachers to understand the social emotional needs of each child
 - Establish a strong relationship with students and families, setting the stage for a successful school career into the future
 - Meet the developmental and cognitive needs of students
 - Appropriately prepare students for the systems and structures of school leading to a successful transition to a rigorous full-day program
 - Support students' success and confidence as learners

Support for Families

- Details regarding After School Care provided at Kindergarten Information Meetings
 - Care provided at each site beginning at 12:30 for the first six weeks of school
 - Free of charge for families that qualify
