CLASS TITLE: BEHAVIOR SUPPORT INTERVENTIONIST

JOB DESCRIPTION:

Under the direction of the Director of Pupil Services, the Behavior Support Interventionist (BSI) is responsible for assisting the Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA) in designing and implementing Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) programs for students with Autism Spectrum Disorder, Emotional Disturbance, ADHD, behavior challenges and other special needs.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Work 1:1 with 1 or more assigned students
- Conduct trainings/overlaps with instructional aides
- Complete 30-day assignments under the direction of the BCBA
- Provide ABA trainings for both Special Day Classes and general education classes as needed
- Implement plans aimed to decrease 1-on-1 instructional aide services
- Ensure proper data collection on IEP goals
- Ensure data is being filed on a monthly basis for assigned students
- Assist with acclimating new students to our district
- Provide general ABA support to SDC and general education classrooms
- Create materials (e.g., token board, visual schedule, social story) for general education and Special Day Classes teachers when needed
- Ensure accommodations and modification are being implemented on a consistent basis
- Collect data to help determine appropriate placement for students
- Collect data to help determine appropriate level of support and services for students
- Meet with the Behavior Support Team on a bi-weekly basis, or as requested by the BCBA
- Ensure correct implementation of reinforcement systems
- Conducts reinforcement hierarchies, preference assessments, etc. as needed
- Ensure Behavior Intervention Plans are being implemented as written
- Additional duties as assigned

- Evidence-based teaching methodologies based on the principles of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA).
- Diagnosis such as Autism Spectrum Disorder, Emotional Disturbance, ADHD and other special needs.
