

DEL MAR UNION SCHOOL DISTRICT Parent COVID-19 Guidance

During this COVID-19 pandemic it is more important than ever to know when to keep your child home to protect the health of our school community. Please follow the directions below which follow the guidelines from the HHSA (Health and Human Services Agency of San Diego County).

If any of the following symptoms:

- Fever with or without chills/rigors (defined as >100 that does not resolve in 30 minutes with/without medication
- Cough
- Nasal congestion/runny nose
- Sore throat (please note even with a diagnosis of strep throat, you must follow directions below)
- Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea
- Fatigue
- New loss of taste/smell
- Headache
- Muscle or body aches
- Poor appetite

Course of Action



1. Keep at home



2. Contact a doctor



3. Return to school

- Please keep your child home *and* contact your school health office for further direction on when your child can return to school (based on HHSA guidelines*) if:
 - Your child has a positive PCR COVID-19 viral test.
 - Your child is presumed to have COVID-19.
 - Someone in your household or a close contact has a positive COVID-19 viral test or is diagnosed with presumed COVID-19.

Your child may return to school:

- With a negative PCR COVID-19 viral test (not antibody test) **and** 24 hours after symptoms have greatly improved and student is fever-free for 24 hours without medication. You will need to provide documentation of the negative test results.
- After 10 days have passed from the first day of symptoms **and** symptoms are <u>significantly</u> improved **and** student is fever-free for 24 hours without medication.

^{*}Students will not be allowed to return to school earlier than current Health and Human Services Agency guidelines.
