

Measure MM Overview

On November 6, 2018, the voters of the Del Mar Union School District authorized Measure MM under the Proposition 39 statutes. Measure MM authorized the issuance of \$186 million in General Obligation Bonds (the "Bonds"). The net proceeds of the Bonds are intended to be used to repair, renovate, upgrade, replace, modernize, and construct school facilities and fund related facilities costs to meet current health, safety and instructional standards which will improve the overall educational experience for all students in the District.




