CORRECTIVE ACTION SUMMARY

Corrective Actions

- Consider sealing/resurfacing asphalt surfaces to prevent the transport of sediment to storm drains.
- Perform housekeeping as needed to keep outdoor areas free of litter, debris, and sediment.
- Keep storm drains on site free of trash, sediment, and liquids.
- Eliminate illicit connections and illicit discharges from entering the storm drain system.
- Perform housekeeping as needed to keep trash storage/disposal areas free of debris, sediment, and liquids.
- Apply erosion control measures in areas with unstabilized slopes. Temporary measures, such as fiber rolls, silt fences, or other structural applications may be used until vegetation or other permanent solutions can be established.
- Adjust irrigation systems to eliminate overwatering/overspray, or leaks.
- Apply pollution-prevention signage to storm drain inlets, such as stencils or medallions with verbage such as "No dumping, drains to ocean".
