Tentative Agreement

- Settlement Agreement concluded after 2 years of negotiations
- Many unknowns complicated negotiations
- Both parties were highly engaged in finding solutions
- Settlement is the second part of the budget solutions process

Tentative Agreement Cont.

- Agreement provides approximately \$1 million in budget solutions
- Agreement includes permanent contract language changes as well as temporary changes that are included in a 1 year Memorandum of Understanding

TA: What is included

- No salary or benefits increases for the 2011-2013 school years
- Contract language changes in the Site-Based Decision-Making and Grievance Articles
- Extends the term of the contract through 2016
- Memorandum of Understanding for 1 year

Memorandum of Understanding

- MOU is temporary (1 year only)
- Increases class size from 20 to 22 in K-3
- Corresponding reduction in ESC
- No upper grade comp or conference days
- Over-class size stipend savings
- Reduced "out of contract pay" for shared contracts

MOU continued

- Offers incentive for early retirement
- ESC Program review committee
- Restoration language in the event of unanticipated or new revenues

Recommendation

 Superintendent recommends modifications to the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Del Mar Teachers Association and the Del Mar Union School District
