



2021-2022 After School Programs Info Sheet

The DMUSD After School Program is pleased to offer an excellent After School Program, at each of our DMUSD sites. Our high quality program is specifically designed to meet the needs of students in the Del Mar Union School District. Students are grouped by like grade level and will participate in a variety of enriching activities including: Steam+ projects, specialty interest clubs, indoor and outdoor play, cooperative learning, snack time*, and a dedicated homework time.

We are hopeful that we will be able to return to a more typical After School experience for our students during the 2021-2022 school year. However, due to the ongoing COVID-19 Pandemic, with the safety of students and staff as our top priority, the After School Program will continue to modify our program to align with guidelines from the CDPH and HHS.

Schedules & Tuition

- There will be three options for schedules:
 - Five days a week: Monday – Friday
 - Three days a week: Monday, Wednesday, Friday
 - Two days a week: Tuesday, Thursday
- The cost of care is based on a weekly fee to attend the program. There are no refunds or credits for unused days. The weekly cost of care for 2021-2022 school year is as follows:
 - 5 day: \$140/ week
 - 3 day: \$96/ week
 - 2 day: \$55/ week
- Care hours will be from school dismissal – 6:00 pm*

**Additional fees will be charged for early dismissal during parent teacher conference week.*

Priority registration and space will be given to students with 5- day/week schedule.

Kindergarten Half-Day

From August 15, 2021- September 24, 2021 when the Kindergarten students are attending half day school, all kinder students will be assessed an additional fee based on their scheduled days to adjust for the additional care.

A non-refundable registration fee of \$75.00 per student is due at the time of registration for all students to the program.

Del Mar Heights

Please register your student's home school as Del Mar Heights on the student registration page. However please enroll your student at the physical school location they will be attending for the 2021-2022 school year.

Billing

After School Care is billed on a monthly basis and due on the first of each calendar month. Financial assistance information is available on the After School Programs portion of the DMUSD website.

Safety

Safety protocols will be adjusted in accordance with the guidelines set forth by Centers for Disease Control and the San Diego County Public Health Department. We are hopeful that with the trend of things we will be able to return to a more typical After School experience for our students. We will continue to monitor the guidelines as the school year approaches and loosen restrictions as the CDC and public health allow.

Admission Requirements
