- Assist with supervision and evaluation of paraprofessionals who work with children on the Autism Spectrum
- Provide training and support for Special Education Staff in strategies for working with children on the Autism Spectrum and in Positive Behavioral Strategies
- Participate in Individual Education Program (IEP) team meetings for students who are on the Autism Spectrum and present behavioral concerns
- Other duties as assigned by the Director of Pupil Services
