

Pesticide Spraying Notification

Del Mar Union School District

Dear Parent or Guardian,

The Healthy Schools Act of 2000 requires all California school districts to notify parents or guardians of pesticides they expect to apply during the school year. The district office and school sites may be treated with the following **ECO-friendly products** and pesticides as needed.

CB-80 Extra	Pyrethring, Piperonyl Butoxide
Drione	Pyrethrin, Silica Aerogel
Maxforce FC	Fipronil
Termidor	Fipronil
Wilco Gopher Getter Type 2 AG Bait	Diphacinone
ECO Via EC*	Thyme Oil, Pencythyl Propionate, Rosemary Oil
Essentria Granules*	Clove Oil, Thyme Oil, Wintergreen Oil

^{*}These chemicals are exempt from notification regulations established by AB2260.
