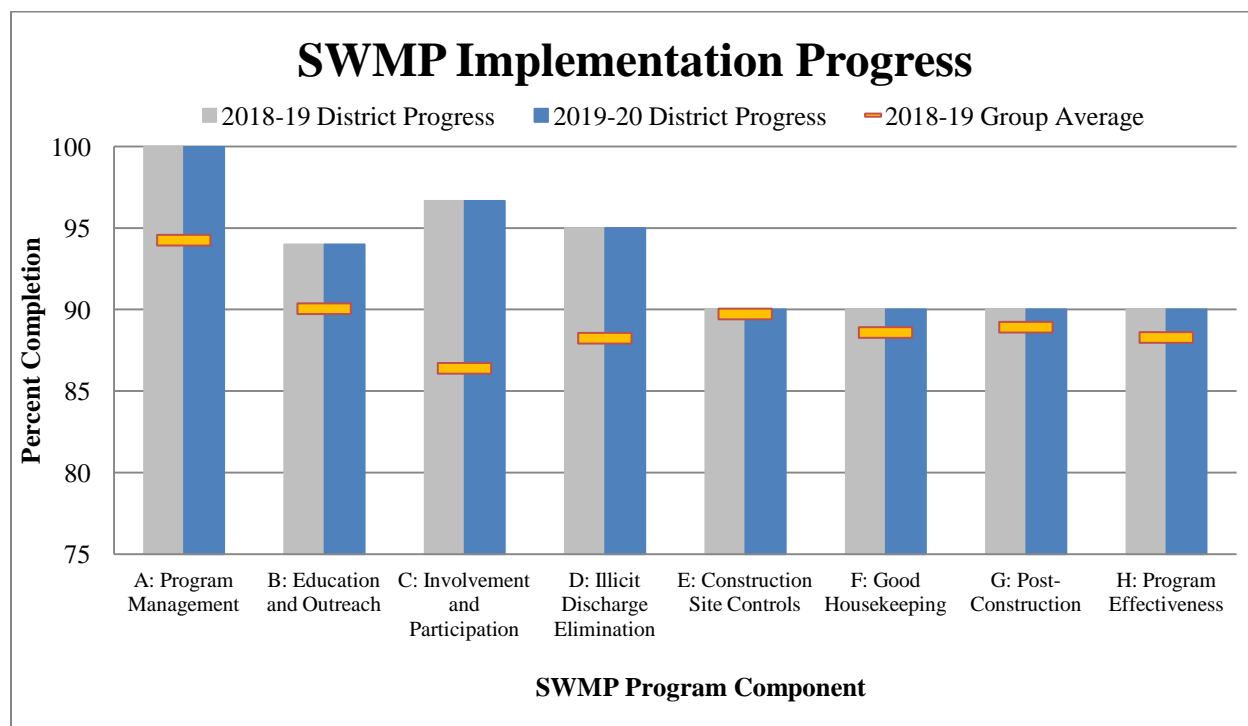
Re: SDCOE Municipal Services - 2019-2020 Site Visit

- 2019-2020 SWMP Annual Progress Report, ready to take to your Cabinet or Board as a discussion item to explain all the hard work and expense of implementing your District's SWMP.
- A Storm Water Program Tracker, which provides a reminder of upcoming and continual progress items, and a space in which to record your efforts.
- Proposed Language for Inclusion in an Annual Report to Your Board or Cabinet. This item may be attached to your Annual Progress Report as a summary for Board or Cabinet review.

The following graph is a visual comparison of your progress in each SWMP component from last year to this, and as compared to group members last year, for your reference.



As you continue to implement your municipal storm water program across all district sites, keep in mind the direction of current and upcoming storm water policies to better prepare for any increased regulatory pressure. Primarily, ensure trash is not entering any storm drains or collecting in areas where it may be carried offsite by wind or rain, and work to prevent any solid or liquid from entering storm drains or flowing offsite. This includes irrigation water and air conditioning condensate.
