

## How Parents Can Support the Integration of Technology at Home

 Encourage your child to practice proper finger positioning during typing practice at home. Your child should be practicing keyboarding skills at least 10 minutes a night 3-4 times a week.

The district has adopted Typing Club for typing practice. Student scores are recorded and their teacher can monitor their progress. <a href="http://dmusd.typingclub.com">http://dmusd.typingclub.com</a>
Students logon with their Google username and password.

Login to Google Docs with your child a few times a month to view his/her work. Your child is proud of his/her work and this is an opportunity to share his/her progress.
 Provide praise on your child's writing or projects. Your child's teacher asks that you do not edit or revise your child's writing or projects. Writing is a process, and it is important for your child's teacher to monitor your child's capabilities in order to properly instruct them.
