



How Parents Can Support the Integration of Technology at Home

- Encourage your child to practice proper finger positioning during typing practice at home. Your child should be practicing keyboarding skills at least 10 minutes a night 3-4 times a week.

The district has adopted Typing Club for typing practice. Student scores are recorded and their teacher can monitor their progress. <http://dmusd.typingclub.com>
Students logon with their Google username and password.

- Login to Google Docs with your child a few times a month to view his/her work. Your child is proud of his/her work and this is an opportunity to share his/her progress. Provide praise on your child's writing or projects. Your child's teacher asks that you do not edit or revise your child's writing or projects. Writing is a process, and it is important for your child's teacher to monitor your child's capabilities in order to properly instruct them.
