HOW THE WORLD HAS CHANGED



DMUSD students continue to perform academically at exceptional levels. Our students scored in the top 1% of school districts in the state in both English Language Arts and Mathematics and DMUSD had the highest percentage of students performing at the *exceeds level* in San Diego County. These results are reflective of dedicated teachers, strong leadership, and support staff who, in partnership with our families, provided the support our students needed during challenging times.
