# DEL MAR HEIGHTS SCHOOL GROUNDBREAKING

The Del Mar Heights School held its long awaited Groundbreaking on March 15, 2022, and work is moving forward on the site! All buildings have been demolished and removed, and the team is working to grade the site and fix the failing outfalls at the edge of the campus that are causing erosion into the Torrey Pines Reserve Extension. Work on the foundations and buildings will begin soon. This rebuild project is expected to be completed in May of 2023.

# DISTRICTWIDE PROJECTS

This summer, playgrounds will be installed at Ashley Falls School and Carmel Del Mar School, and classrooms will be modernized at all sites across the district.

## PACIFIC SKY SCHOOL OPENING

Construction is ongoing at Pacific Sky School. Building structures are complete, and interiors are coming together. The site is anticipated to open on August 15, 2022, and the new central kitchen will be finished by January of 2023. We look forward to inviting members of the community to an open house to view the Pacific Sky campus before school opens in August.

#### **DEL MAR HILLS ACADEMY MODERNIZATION**

Planning for the Del Mar Hills Academy Modernization continues to progress. The design team is working through the schematic design phase while also conducting required geotechnical investigation and survey work. Next steps include selecting a builder who will join the team and help with plans for construction timing and phasing.
